AIROLA LOGISTIC HUB FIRE: NO INJURIES

The initial data from ARPAC state that the air quality has not exceeded legal limits

The company confirms that the fire that occurred yesterday at the Airola logistic hub - where finished products are stored, destined for customers, with 100% recyclable materials - has not caused any injuries.

The flames spread to the roof, causing a large-scale fire also due to the strong wind. The logistic hub was equipped with surveillance cameras, the company will employ all necessary forces to identify the causes of the incident together with the authorities.

Regarding the smoke caused by the flames, the initial data from ARPAC's air quality monitoring state that
