POST AIROLA FIRE: WORKING GROUP WITH THE PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION

The working group will also include Tecnobios of Apollosa, an independent company specialized in laboratory analysis, attentive to environmental issues and to the protection of people's health.

Following the serious fire on October 14, a working group has been established between SAPA SpA and the Public Administration, aimed at protecting the health of people and the environment.

The first meeting took place today.

The approved agreement model provides, according to the requests of the Public Administration, the participation of an independent company, Tecnobios of Apollosa, specialized in laboratory analysis and always sensitive and attentive to environmental issues and to the protection of people's health.

The working group with the Public Administration and independent companies aligns with what is prescribed by environmental norms and policies (such as ISO 14000), in consulting the population to act solely in the public interest, avoiding partisan interests.

Furthermore, the company's history is closely linked to the territory through 20 years of social activity, first with the Agape committee, and now with the Angelo Affinita Foundation.
